

OVERVIEW OF JOB ROLE: Policy Planning Programme Manager

BACKGROUND

- Overseeing team responsible for CIL/S106 controls, production of the IDS and monitoring of development delivery producing corporate and statutory reports.
- Overseeing and developing our policy capabilities around sustainability, heritage, biodiversity and climate change.
- Managing a complex workload alongside leading team of c. 6 plus consultants, plus support to senior colleagues.
- Preparation and potentially giving of evidence to Examinations in Public and at planning appeals, plus providing policy advice including representations to policy / legislation.
- Engaging with colleagues, Members, internal and external stakeholders and the public.
